MLAs witness expertise of Seagoe tyre disposal firm

A CROSS-party delegation from the Northern Ireland Assembly paid a visit to the Seagoe-based tyre re-cycling company R4 this week to see their methods of dealing with discarded tyres.

The group was shown round by managing director Lynn Kerr who explained how they

retreaded some of the tyres and re-cycled others for schemes like reconstruction projects, road surfacing, landfill, river bank reinstatement and base for civic amenities. The firm operates in Northern Ireland and in the border countries of the Republic. Said Lynn Kerr: "It was all part

of an investigation by Assembly members into the disposal of waste, with tyres particularly in focus. They wanted to see how it was done professionally, and they were all deeply interested and impressed in our process."
